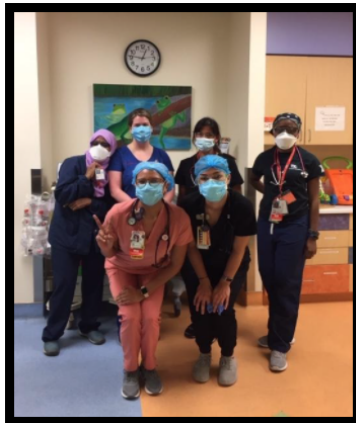

- Watkins Mill HS

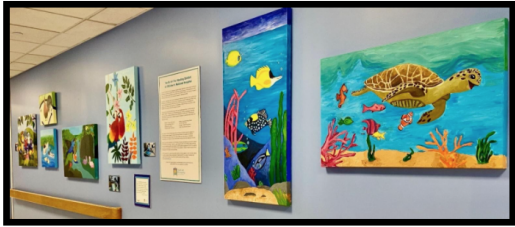
